Although it is protected from the winds, it is best to avoid it on those days with northerly winds.

On the coast you will find wonderful golden sand, which combined with the shallow blue–green waters create an exotic landscape and also suitable conditions for families with children to visit.

On the larger beaches you will find umbrellas and sunbeds for rent but there is also space available to use your own equipment.

There may not be a beach bar, but in the tavernas located on the beach and above it, you can get the essentials during your visit as well as have lunch.

Also on the plus side is the amazing seabed that is worth diving to see while water sports enthusiasts will not be left complaining as there are facilities for this purpose.

The route from the island to Magganari can be one of the longest on the island and one of the most tiring, however the scenery upon arrival will compensate you.

It is worth mentioning that the filming of the movie "Infinite Blue" took place in Magganari.

Access can be done by road with your private car via the paved road or by private buses that depart from the country.

Finally, you can also arrive with the excursion boats that depart daily from the island for Magganari and other beaches of the island.
